

Understanding the upkeep symbols



Washing



Do not machine wash
 → § Professional cleaning below



Hand wash only, at a maximum temperature of 40°C, normal rinse and spin with care



Machine wash at (30°C)



Without hyphen: Normal machine action, normal rinse and normal spin



One hyphen: Synthetic program (medium speed). Reduced machine action, rinse at decreasing temperature and reduced spin
Two hyphens: Wool program (minimum speed)

Bleaching



Do not bleach



All types of bleaching allowed



Bleaching with oxygen releasing agents only

Drying



Do not tumble dry

This is the case for all chain saw protective clothing. In this case, line drying after spinning is advised (instructions and advice in the usage note)



Tumble drying allowed

One point: Drying at moderated temperature (60 °C maximum)



Two points: Drying at normal temperature (80 °C maximum)



Ironing



Do not iron



Iron



Iron on cool (110 °C)



Iron on hot (150 °C)



Iron on very hot (200 °C)

Professional cleaning



Do not dry clean



Dry cleaning with perchloroethylene solvents, petrol-based solvents (mineral essences).



One hyphen: Reduce washing (quantity of water, machine stress, temperature of wash, drying temperature).



Two hyphens: Strong reduction of washing (quantity of water, machine stress, temperature of wash, drying temperature)



Water-washable by professionals



One hyphen: Reduction of washing (quantity of water, machine stress).



Two hyphens: Strong reduction of washing (quantity of water, machine stress, temperature of wash, drying temperature)
